#### **Custer County/Beulah. Aspen Acres Fire:**

### **USPS Operations**

**The Beulah Post Office (located at 8820 CO-78) has been impacted** by the Aspen Acres Fire, as the entire town of Beulah is currently under a **mandatory evacuation order** . Operations are suspended, and mail service is temporarily halted as residents leave the area due to the threat of the wildfire.

While the exact status of the physical building has not been determined as crews actively battle the blaze , post offices in mandatory evacuation zones typically suspend operations and hold mail at an alternate facility until it is safe for employees to return.
